

FEEDBACK REPORT 2020-21

STUDENT FEEDBACK REPORT

A total of 107 responses were gathered from the students which included students from BSc (56.1 %) response, BA (28%) and B.Com (15.9%). 41.1% of the 5th semester, 30.8% of 1st semester and 28% of the 3rd semester students responded about their course experience.

Response above course content prescribed by university: 40.2% of the students felt it was good while 31.08% 31.8% opined it to be excellent and 21.5% of them mentioned as very good. The suggestions given by our students shall be communicated to the university through our faculty who are serving as the members of the BOS.

When asked about the prescribed time scheduled in completing each module majority of them (37.4%) mentioned as good, 29.9% as very good and 26.02% as excellent.

Asked about the text books available in the library 33.6% of them felt they were good 33.6% as very good and 24.3% as excellent.


Regarding availability of e-resources 33.6% said it was excellent while 31.8% as good and 25.2% as very good.

With regards to curriculum design in promoting teaching learning majority of them (38.3%) felt it was good, 26.2% felt it was very good while 29% felt it was excellent.

When asked about the in time completion of syllabus the students felt it was good (31.8%) , 30.8% of them felt it was very good and 27.1% opined to be excellent and 7.5% felt it was average.

About the range and content of the syllabus, 40.2% felt it was absolutely in synchronization with the present market need, 29.9% felt it was excellent and 21.5% were of the opinion that it was very good.

The respondents rated the curriculum design as 23.6% as good, 29% as very good and 27.1% as excellent.


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Student's feedback on teachers

A total of 268 students belonging to science stream responded about their teachers 55.6% of them from final year, 28.4% from 1st se, and 15.3% from 3rd sem responded.

A total of eight teachers were assessed by the students and when asked about the content of the session being useful and interesting 62.3% felt is as excellent, 24.6% as very good and 11.2% as good.

51.1% of them opined the topics covered to be relevant, 28% felt it to be very good and 15.7% as good.

About the overall teaching 54.5% felt to be excellent, 24.3% as very good teaching sessions were conducted and 16.4% felt it to be good.

When asked about the structured and well organized sessions 51.1% said they were excellent, 25% as very good and 19.8% as good enough.

55.2% of the students felt the overall delivery of the sessions were excellent, 20.9% of them felt it to be very good and 18.78% felt it to be good.

The study material gives to the students was excellent 48.1% whereas 26.5% thought to be very good and 19.8% as good.


96.6% felt were given adequate time for raising their queries and discussions, 95.1% of the students felt the applicability of their knowledge in their workplace

About listing out the good aspects of teaching the mentioned teaching to be good, excellent clarity in teaching, identifying the topics, good explanation, conceptual understanding, discussing curriculum with general knowledge, good communication skills of the faculty explanations with PPT's, coordinators, conversation, methodology fluency and thoroughness, interaction.

Regarding bringing in improvement in aspects of teaching students suggested:

To increase use of smart classes, method of teaching, teaching with examples.

Conversations with students. The institution shall try to incorporate all these suggestions towards further improving the teaching process and making learning more interesting and productive.

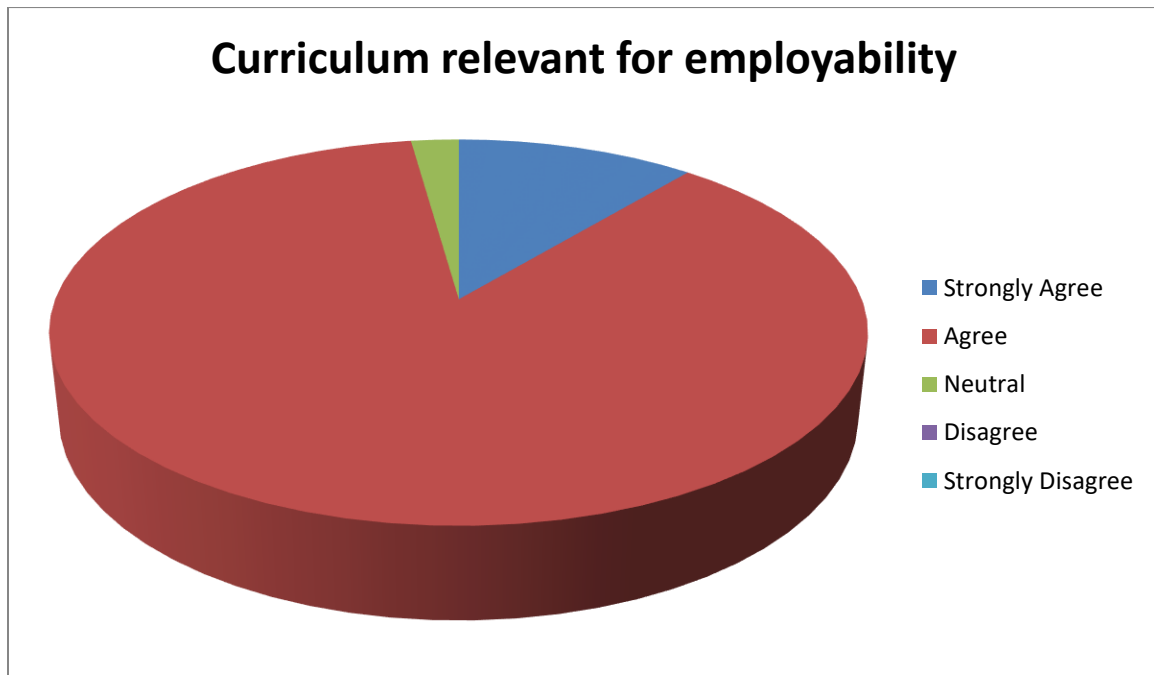

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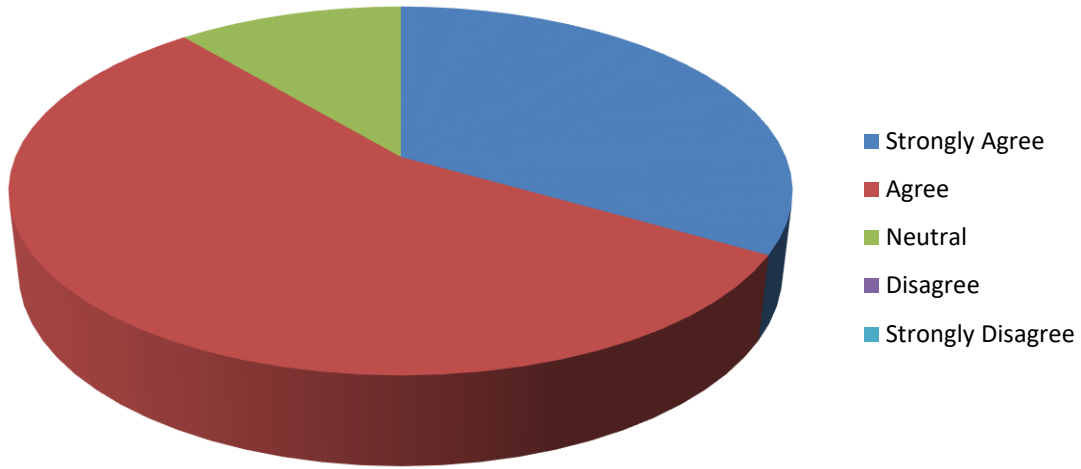
EMPLOYER'S FEEDBACK 220-21

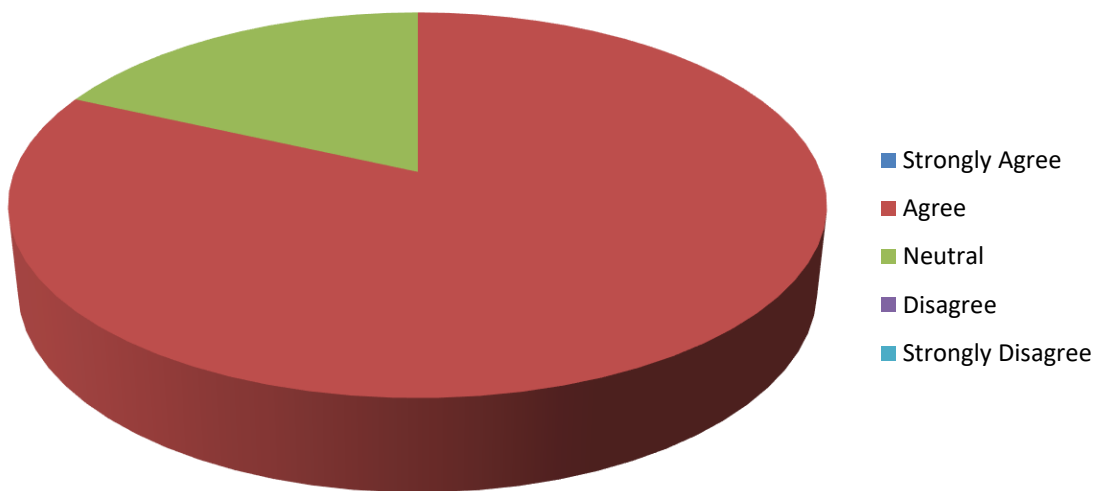

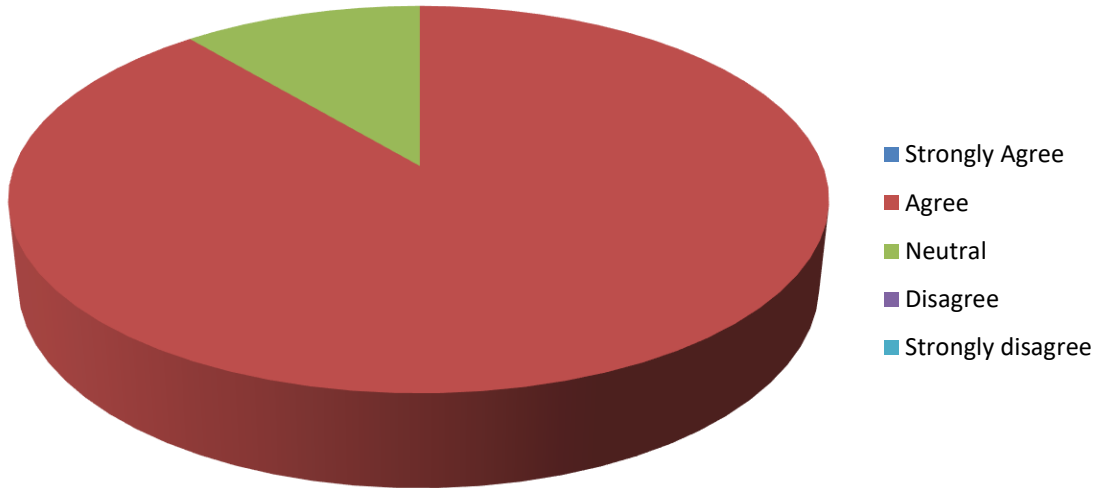
Curriculum effective in developing innovative thinking



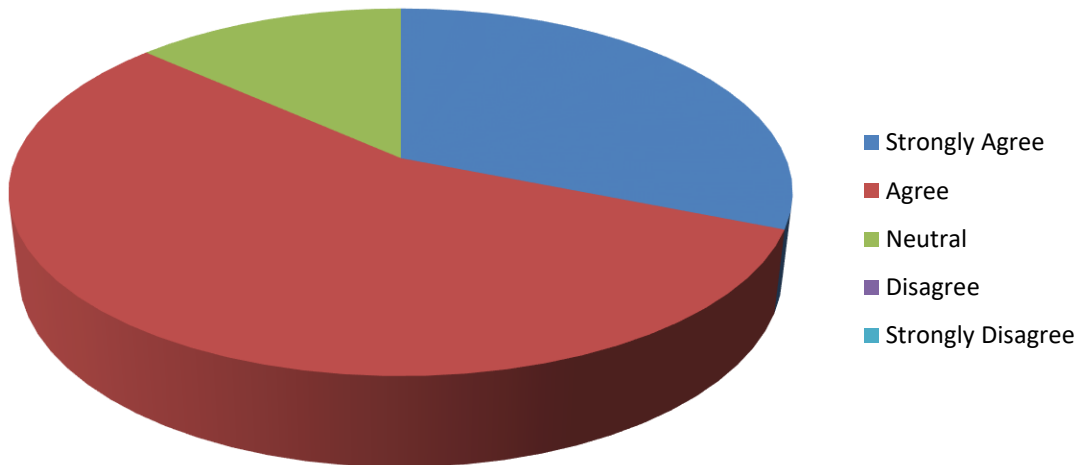
Syllabus effective in developing skill oriented

In general the employers are happy with the student of the our institute and they rated the performance of our students as “Good” and “Satisfactory”


The employers reported that they would like to employ more students from our institute.
